The Special Education Advisory Committee (SEAC) is a forum that brings together parents, staff, students and the community. The purpose of SEAC is to ensure meaningful and sustainable communication, while disseminating information, sponsoring presentations, and discussing the impact of state legislation related to students with disabilities. Our goal is to support the educational experience of our students with disabilities and to advocate for continuous improvement within BVSD.

We meet the 2nd Wednesday of the month at the BVSD Education Center, alternating months between mornings (11 AM-1PM) and evening (6-8 PM) meetings.

Each meeting includes;

- Member/Parent/Community Input
- Presentations/Education
- Discussion with the Directors of Special Education

Our foundation is parents and we invite a parent representative from every BVSD school (including preschools and transition services). Parent reps can share seats and everyone is always welcome to attend our public meetings. The parent members are expected to report back to their school governing committee such as PTO or SIT so that special education has a natural seat at the table.
